
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Competency Validation

Donning and Doffing – Gown, Gloves, Mask or Respirator, Eye Protection

Donning PPE	Correct	Incorrect
1. Perform Hand Hygiene		
2. Don Gown:		
 Fully covering torso from neck to knees, arms to end of wrists Fasten in the back of neck and waist 		
3. Don Mask or NIOSH approved, fit-tested N95 (or equivalent)		
Secure ties/elastic bands at middle of head & neck		
Fit flexible band to nose bridge Fit spug to foce and below ship		
Fit snug to face and below chin4. Don Goggles or Face Shield:		
Place over face and eyes and adjust to fit		
5. Don Gloves:		
Extend to cover wrist of gown		
Doffing PPE		
1. Remove Gloves:		
 Using a gloved hand, grasp outside of glove with opposite gloved hand; peel off 		
Hold removed glove in the opposite gloved hand		
 Slide fingers of ungloved hand under remaining glove at wrist and peel off second glove Discard gloves in waste container 		
 Outside of the gloves are contaminated. If your hands get contaminated during glove 		
removal, immediately wash your hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer		
2. Remove Goggles or Face Shield:		
 Remove from the back by lifting head band or ear pieces 		
 Discard in designated receptacle if re-processed or in waste container 		
Outside of the goggles or face shield are contaminated. If your hands get contaminated		
during goggles or face shield removal, immediately wash your hands or usealcohol-based hand sanitizer		
3. Remove Gown:		
 Unfasten ties/fastener taking care that sleeves don't contact your body when reaching forties 		
 Pull away from neck and shoulders, touching inside of gown only 		
Turn gown inside out		
Fold or roll into bundle and discard		
Gown front and gown sleeves are contaminated. If your hands get contaminated during gown Tomoval, immediately work your hands or use an elegable based hand sonitizer.		
removal, immediately wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer 4. Remove Mask NIOSH approved, fit-tested N95 (or equivalent):		
Front of the mask is contaminated – DO NOT TOUCH!		
 If your hands get contaminated during gown removal, immediately wash your hands or use ar 		
alcohol-based hand sanitizer		
Grasp bottom, then top ties or elastics and remove without touching the front of the mask		
Discard in waste container		
5. Perform Hand Hygiene after removing all PPE		
 Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds OR 		
Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer		
Perform hand hygiene between steps if hands become contaminated		

Standard Precautions & Transmission Based Precautions	Correct	Incorrect
23. Staff correctly identifies the appropriate PPE for the following scenarios:		
a. Standard Precautions (PPE to be worn based on anticipated level of exposure)*		
b. Contact/Contact Enteric Precautions (gown & gloves)		
c. Droplet Precautions (surgical mask with eye protection)		
d. Airborne Precautions (OSHA approved, fit-tested respirator if applicable)		

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)
The type of PPE used will vary based on the level of precautions req airborne infection isolation precautions. The procedure for putting o ype of PPE.	
Page 1. GOWN Fully cover torso from neck to knees, arms to end of wrists, and wrap around the back Fasten in back of neck and waist	
2. MASK OR RESPIRATOR	
 Secure ties or elastic bands at middle of head and neck Fit flexible band to nose bridge Fit snug to face and below chin Fit-check respirator 	
3. GOGGLES OR FACE SHIELD • Place over face and eyes and adjust to fit	
4. GLOVES • Extend to cover wrist of isolation gown
